President's Message

Aloha Members,

As the Club's fiscal year comes to a close I am excited to share with you our progress both in membership growth and improvements. Currently over 650 memberships strong, we are looking ahead to achieving capacity.

The 2016/2017 budget has been approved and I am pleased to announce that there is no increase in monthly membership dues. Capital dues will increase by \$10 for all membership classes. The difference between the two is that monthly dues are allocated to general operating expenses, while capital dues are budgeted specifically for capital expenses.



A highlight last year was the rebuild of courts #1 and #2 with premium Plexicushion, resulting in MCC having two of the finest courts in the Islands. Two state-of-the-art lawn mowers replaced the 14 and 23-year-old models increasing efficiency and the beauty of our course. Ten EZ GO golf carts were added to the fleet; and the replacement of the obsolete control panel at the well pump has made a noticeable difference in improved irrigation. Remodeled Golf Pro Shop restrooms and the current rebuild of the forward tees are much appreciated and long overdue.

Ahead in the new fiscal year, we have budgeted capital to continue renovating the Golf Pro Shop, purchasing a grinder to sharpen the lawn mower blades, eight new EZ GO golf carts and replacing the electrical service unit at the well pump. Tennis courts 3 & 4 will be resurfaced and the Club's management operating system upgraded.

The Club introduced the Refundable Equity Membership (REM) as a recruitment enhancement to membership in 2010. This was highly effective as the economy continued to recover and six years later we find ourselves close to being at capacity. With this important milestone, the Board decided that the Club will return to offering memberships without the REM component effective May 1st. This change affects only the new members joining the Club; existing REM members continue with the right of refundability which was in effect when they joined the Club. There is still time for your friends or family members to join before the deadline of April 30, 2016.

The Club is in the process of validating our current By-laws. This process necessitated delaying the Board election for one month and the annual meeting is postponed to June 26.

Thank you all for your part in making our Club "The Best Club in the World!"

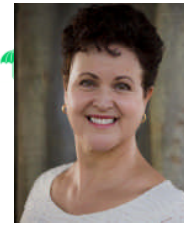

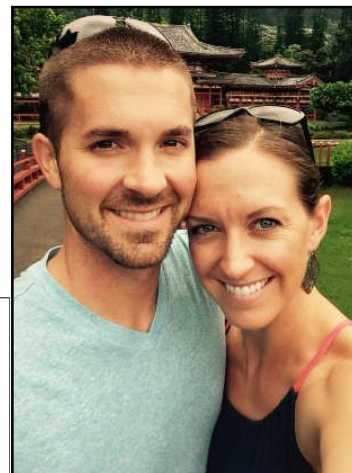

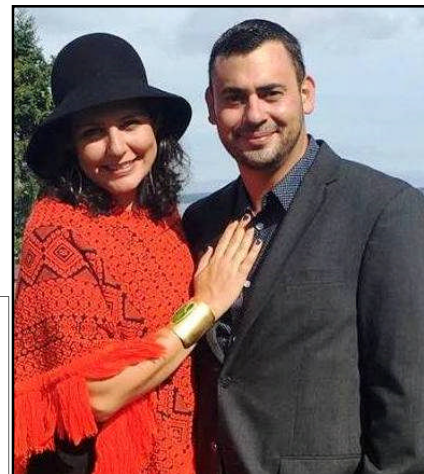

In Memoriam



This month, Maui Country Club again marks the passing of a beloved Super Senior Member, Mary Jane McBarnet. In her honor, and the legacy of their family membership, we remember Mary Jane with aloha.

Although born in San Francisco, Mary Jane graduated from Punahou on Oahu and continued on to college at UC Berkeley, graduating with a degree in Economics. Hawaiian at heart, she loved to surf and

danced hula throughout her life. Mary Jane served in the Women's Air Raid Defense during WWII and went on to work for the State Department at US Embassies in Brazil and India. It was in Madras, India in 1949 when she met and married husband Alex J.W. McBarnet Sr. and the two returned to Hawaii.

The young McBarnet family relocated to Maui in 1954 and Mary Jane took a position with HC&S in Community Relationships. She was very involved in the preparation of Seabury Hall for its opening in 1964; and with husband Alex, they opened Maui Oil in 1982. She spent time in Scotland each year, and authored a book on the McBarnet (MacPherson) and Gunn family genealogies.

It was in 1954 that the McBarnets joined Maui Country Club, raising their family here in Spreckelsville. Sons Alec and Terry continue as life-long members, along with their families. We recognize with appreciation Mary Jane's 62 years of membership and happy memories.

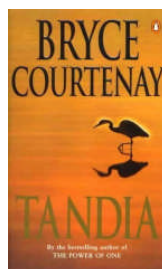
